



'My Pony Experience at Camping at Devon's Crealy

On Arrival

- On arrival to Camping at Devon's Crealy, please report to reception. You will be asked to complete a form detailing vehicle registration / length of stay etc and be issued with wristbands to allow you entrance into the park for the duration of your stay.
- Our reception staff will direct you to the camping field where you will choose and set up your pitch.

Being introduced

- Please report to Reception at 3pm on your day of arrival, who will contact an Animal Wrangler to greet you and take you to be introduced to your miniature pony. You will be provided with a badge that you are **required to wear** during the times you care for your pony. An adult is required to accompany the children for this introduction.
- Our Animal Wranglers will inform you the name of your miniature pony and explain all the rules regarding the care of the pony and ask the family to sign a disclaimer stating this.
- The minimum age that children can care for their ponies unaccompanied by an adult is 16 years old.

Your daily experience

The times for the morning activities are:

- 8.30am Hand milk the house cow
- 9am Help to bring the ponies in from the paddocks
- 9.30am Help to give the rabbits and guinea-pigs their breakfast
- The Animal Wrangler will then show you the stable where your allocated pony resides. The pony's name will be on the head collar.
- You are able to groom your pony at leisure, and will be given a grooming bag and lead rope.
- Our ponies are kept in the stables by day and the fields at night.
- You will receive a demonstration of how to lead your pony by its lead rope.
- You are welcome to lead your pony around the park between 8-10am, and are able to groom your pony in the stables from 10am-12pm and 2pm-5pm. At 5pm please meet the Animal Wranglers at the animal barn to take

your pony to the field for the night followed by optional animal housekeeping of your pony's stable.

- We ask that ponies are not taken out of the park grounds or taken to the Campsite.
- The ponies are not for riding – we do not provide bridles or saddles.
- If you have any further questions regarding the below – please do not hesitate to contact a member of reception or an Animal Wrangler.

Introducing the ponies:

Kirsty is a 24yr old Black miniature Shetland mare. Retired from breeding and has lived at Crealy for over 15yrs.

Folly is a 10-year-old Miniature Shetland mare, dun colour, homebred at Crealy and has bred a foal.

Malteser, 3yrs, British Spotted, bay gelding, homebred at Crealy and loves going in the grooming pen.

Sika - 17 yrs, British Spotted brood mare, has lived at Crealy since 2002 - Sika is Malteser's mum

Dinky is a 12yr old chestnut miniature Shetland gelding and was born here at Crealy.

Philly is a 10 yr old grey miniature Shetland mare. Bred here at Crealy.

Toyah is a 14yr old chestnut Shetland mare. Retired from breeding and came to live at Crealy last year.

Pip is a 17yr old grey miniature Shetland mare. Retired from breeding and lived at Crealy for over 15 years.

J-J is a 14 yr old black Shetland gelding. Sometimes gives pony-rides. Has lived at Crealy for 9 years.

Fun is a 3yr old miniature spotted filly. Bred here at Crealy.

Nikitais a 2yr old miniature spotted filly. Bred here at Crealy.

Olympia is a 1yr old dun miniature Shetland filly. Bred here at Crealy.

Oscar is a 1yr old bay spot bred gelding. Bred here at Crealy.

Peanut is a 3yr old black spot bred gelding. Came to live at Crealy last year.

Jemima is a 6yr old spotted mare. Bred here at Crealy.
